## New Course Number: HLC-514. Foundation / Intro to Expressive Arts as Transformation

The course was formerly numbered HLC-582 and has now been changed to HLC-514.

This is the primary foundation / intro course for the Expressive Arts program; it serves as an elective for the Counseling programs, and as a prerequisite for the full CGS/CAGS program in the Professional Application of the Expressive Arts.

Course meets 2 weekends on campus, with guided study time between weekends:

JUNE 15-16; JULY 20-21, 2024; (Sat-Sun. 9:30am - 4:30pm)

#### Finding courses: Grad Summer, Session 1, Session 2

While registering online through the Campus Portal and Course Catalog you'll see that the sessions for each semester are sub-listed with Grad Summer - Grad Summer Session 1, Grad Summer Session 2, etc.

If you are looking for a class but cannot find it in the main semester, try typing in the course Number, (HLC-514, etc) as it may not always obvious about which part of the semester you'll find your course.

For example, for Expressive Arts courses:

HLC-514 Foundations / Intro to Expressive Arts is listed in regular Summer Graduate Session (as elective / prerequisite)

while the specialty HLC-592 Arts Nature and Eco-consciousness class (as elective) is listed in Summer Session II for Summer2024.

#### Dates: For Weekend and Hybrid courses

The weekend dates may not always be clearly visible there on the course catalog pages.

Try clicking on the course on the registration page for further details that are not visible.

If you have questions about dates for Expressive Arts weekend courses then please contact us for clarity.

#### TIMING for Registration:


If you plan to take a course that meets for part of the semester, it is now essential that you register by the Beginning of the Semester for classes.

For example, if you're registering for HLC514: Foundations / Intro to Expressive Arts, which first meets in June,

it will be necessary to still register in April or May as space allows, before the actual semester begins.

Registration for Summer opens: April 3rd at 12am.


Payment arrangements can still be worked out with Business Office, but the registration itself needs to be completed early.
